Plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement

The IQAC of our institution decided the following plan of action for the academic year 2009-2010.

- 1. The committee decided to increase infrastructural facilities.

Section B

1) Activities reflecting the Goals and Objectives of the Institution:-

- For achieving community development the NSS unit of our institution arranged Youth Camp at village Vaijala from 22nd to 28 th December 2009. 116 boys and 34 girls' volunteer students participated and contributed in digging 72 soak pits of latrine. They completed the construction of 05 latrines. A booklet informing about Swine Flue, published by department of Chemistry, was distributed in Beed, Patoda, Ashti, Kada towns and nearby villages. It helped to create awareness among people about Swine Flue. The same booklet was also distributed in schools and colleges in the town. The volunteers also participated in village cleaning campaign. Blood group determination camp was also conducted in village Vailjala in which blood groups of 78 villagers were determined.
- On 7th December 2009, 70 students and staff members as well as citizens donated blood in Blood donation camp organized in college.
- Red Ribbon Club, Disaster Management Club, First Aid service, was inaugurated in the college.
- The volunteers of NSS participated in Pulse Polio Campaign conducted by Rural Hospital, Patoda. Aids awareness week was also organized.
- Orientation lectures were organized for volunteers on every Tuesday and Friday at 4 pm to 5 pm.
- Two girls of NSS participated in State level camp on Women's Empowerment held at Choundi.
- Department of Home Science organized a training camp on knitting on 10 th September 2009. 12 girls participated in the camp. Embroidery training camp was organized on 6th January 2010 in which 15 girls participated. Through the trainings of Stitching, Knitting and Embroidery, the students are inspired for self-employment and self-reliance.
- 25 students were enrolled in 'Earn while you Learn' scheme. Plants nourishment and care, cleaning and maintenance of articles and equipments in Library, Laboratory, Students cooperative Store, Computer department, are the works through which the students realize importance of work and earn to support their education. In year 2009-

2010 the students manufactured 1000 home-work books, 80 dozens candles and 50 boxes of chalk.

- Adults Continuing Education and Extension Services Committee organized a training camp for volunteers on 25 th August 2009. A campaign for Transparency in Examinations was conducted in which message of copy-free examinations was delivered.
- International Literacy Week was observed from 8th to 15th September 2009. Lectures, Elocution and Essay competitions were organized. A lecture providing information on empowerment of democracy, Panchayat Raj, Preamble, Rights and Duties of Indian citizens, was delivered on 6th October 2009. A group discussion of students, parents and teachers was held on 10th February 2010. The topic was "Consequences of malpractices in examination". Environment awareness, health and campus cleaning campaign were conducted in the town. Medical Officer of rural hospital guided the students and people.
- A program on 'Agriculture and useful agricultural activities for farmers's was organized at village Mahasangvi, in which successful farmer Mr. Ashok Garje delivered his lecture. Importance of water harvesting, farm- lakes, cultivation of fruits and flowers, animal husbandry was conveyed to the farmers of the village.
- A gathering for formation of Self-help groups was organized in the town in which manager of Marathwada Bank guided the people. Empowerment and self-reliance of women was insisted in the discussion.
- A program on social awareness was conducted in Bhameshwar School, Patoda, insisting upon National Integrity, Communal harmony as well as consequences of drug addiction, smoking, tobacco chewing, drinking. The Cultural group of our college performed street play on these issues.
- 'Students counseling and entrepreneurship guidance' camp was organized on 5th and 6th January 2010. Personality development, job opportunities, scope for entrepreneurship, writing bio-data, guidance of competitive examinations, news writing skills, lecture of successful entrepreneur, were the topics of guidance to the students.

- "Earn while you Learn" scheme is available in the college. 25 students were enrolled for this scheme. They are paid remuneration of 10/- rupees per day in turn of their two hours' work in the campus.
- Savitribai Phule Adoption Scheme is also run in the college. The scheme is for women students remaining regularly present for classes and who are economically backward. We distribute stationary and books to students. The expenses are borne by the college. 72 women students of Junior and Senior wing were enrolled for this scheme.
- Students having good achievements in sports are given special concession in fees at admission.

• Some of the members of Alumni Association delivered lectures on various topics under the programs of Adult Continuing Education and Extension Services. Some members of the association participated in annual gathering. They sponsored prizes for the competing students in *Antakshari*, Singing, Dancing, Poetry recital, Fancy dress, and other competitions in the gathering. Alumni Association members also sponsored prizes for competitive examinations conducted in college. They participated in Students-Teachers-Parents gathering.
